nims compliant it is necessary for entities to adhere to the standards practices and or minimum criteria presented in the nims guidance documents it is also important to note that although a state local or tribal government or ngo is not required to apply for federal preparedness assistance hspd 5 requires federal departments and agencies to make adoption of nims by state local and tribal governments and ngos a condition for federal preparedness assistance through grants contracts and other activities
