the majority of its students in scotland are postgraduates with only one year to grasp the vast skills and knowledge required to become a primary teacher therefore for many school placement is a source of stress and worry this book combines the information and support that students need to help them prepare for enjoy and maximise the benefits of teaching placements for their professional development it has been specifically written for the education system in scotland taking full account of the differences in practice and terminology that make english books of little use to trainees in scotland
